U. S. Chamber Update

June 28, 2005 The House of Representative passed the Junk Fax Prevention Act, which enables American businesses to continue to communicate with their customers without added government red tape. The junk fax legislation, S. 714, reverses a decision by the FCC that would have create a monumental and costly administrative burden on associations and businesses by requiring them to obtain the signed written consent of each recipient before any commercial fax may be sent. With the passing of this new legislation, associations and businesses are free to send faxes to customers with whom they have existing business relationships. Without this new legislation, the ability of associations and businesses to communicate with their customers would have been severely hampered.
