2015 Group Rating Annual Safety Training

As a group-experience or group-retrospective rating program sponsor for the January 1, 2015 PEC (public) rating year or July 1, 2015 PA (private) rating year, your organization is required to attend annual training per OAC 4123-17-68.

The webinar is scheduled to last approximately 90 minutes and will include BWC program updates and pertinent safety information to share with your members.

OSHA Extends Comment Period for Proposed Rule Clarifying Employers Continuing Obligation to Make and Maintain Accurate Records of Injuries and Illnesses

The proposed rule has been issued in light of the decision of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit in

AKM LLC v. Secretary of Labor (Volks) to clarify its long-standing position that the duty to record an injury or illness continues for as long as the employer must keep records of the recordable injury or illness. The proposed amendments add no new compliance obligations; the proposal would not require employers to make records of any injuries or illnesses for which records are not already required.

Under the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, employers are responsible for providing safe and healthful workplaces for their employees. OSHA's role is to ensure these conditions for America's working men and women by setting and enforcing standards, and providing training, education and assistance.

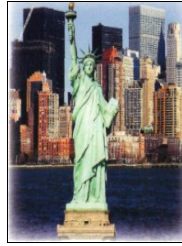
