



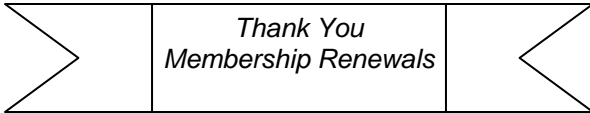

IMMEDIATE THREAT/SECONDARY THREAT

Most accidents are not caused by Immediate Threats but what is called a **Secondary Threat**. These situations are either not perceived by the employee as dangerous or the employee doesn't believe he/she will be injured by performing this

task or activity. These situations are relatively common and many times go unnoticed and aren't seen as a real danger. Therefore, they go uncorrected. Employees get used to them and perform the task or activity as part of their daily routine.

Credit Card Theft

Credit card thieves have found a new way to prey on unsuspecting victims, calling them in the middle of the night in their hotel rooms.

The BBB says the caller pretends to be a hotel employee, and says the hotel's computer system has crashed, and they need your credit card number again.

The caller sometimes offers a discount on the room price for the inconvenience of waking you from slumber. The BBB says it's not sure if the calls are coming from another guest in the hotel, or from someone outside the hotel who has access to the phone numbers of each room.

If you get a call like this, hang up and call the front desk, or make a trip in person. Don't provide your credit card number over the phone, no matter how convincing the caller is... by Paul Muschick, Associated Press

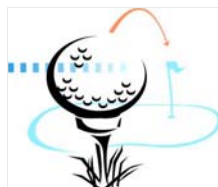
