Governor DeWine Issues Statement on BWC Rate Decrease for Private Employers

(COLUMBUS, Ohio)—Ohio Governor Mike DeWine today issued the following statement in response to [the decision of the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Board of Directors to reduce average premium rates for private employers by 20 percent](#). The cut is the largest private employer rate cut in nearly 60 years and will save these employers more than \$200 million.

"Thanks to this substantial rate decrease, Ohio's private employers will see significant cost-savings that they can reinvest in their products and employees," said Governor DeWine. "This is a positive step toward helping to ensure that Ohio's economy continues to thrive."
