Free Credit Report Deadline Extended

The three major credit bureaus have extended the period they are providing access to your credit reports for free to April 20, 2022. Under the federal law American consumers are entitled to get just one free credit report a year. You can get your weekly credit reports at annual-creditreport.com.

License Expiration

Due to the ongoing pandemic, Gov. Mike DeWine has signed Ohio License Bill 404, which extends the expiration date of driver licenses (DL), identification cards (ID) and vehicle registrations beyond December 1, 2020. Now, if a customer's expiration date on their DL, ID, or vehicle registration is March 9 to April 1, 2021, the expiration date has been automatically extended and will remain valid until July 1, 2021.

Avoid Sharing Your COVID-19 Vaccination Card on Social Media Here's Why —

When you get vaccinated for COVID-19, you will receive a vaccination card. This card contains your personal information, including:
 Your first and last name
 Your date of birth
 Your patient ID number
 The date and location of your vaccination

Even though your vaccination card may not contain your Social Security Number or Medicare Number, scammers can still use it to your disadvantage. Avoid potential scams by keeping your card to yourself.

The Southern Ohio Chamber Alliance has joined forces with the Northern Ohio Area Chambers of Commerce, the Central Ohio Chambers of Commerce, the Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce, and the Youngstown/Warren Regional Chamber to form a self-funded medical benefit plan aimed at sole proprietors and small employers with 2 to 50 employees.

The SOCA Benefit Plan is a multiple employer welfare arrangement. Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield

provides claims administration and stop loss protection. Participating employers are required to maintain membership with a Chamber of Commerce that is authorized to offer the Plan. Distribution of the Plan is limited to Anthem appointed brokers who have completed product-specific training. The Plan is governed by a Board of Trustees elected by participating employers.

The Plan is offered by more than 280 local Chambers of Commerce in Ohio and through a distribution network of approximately 500 insurance professionals.
