- ✓ Don't accept calls from strangers.
- ✓ Avoid "miracle cures."
- ✓ Remember, "too good to be true" probably is.
- ✓ Check all sources.

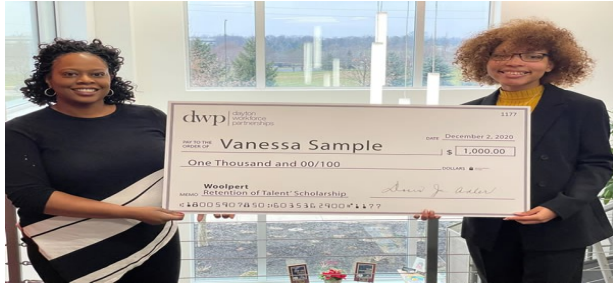
